

HK Pathway (PR) Stream A: In-Canada Graduates (ends 31Aug 2026)

“With flexible open work permits and a fast-track to permanent residency, skilled Hong Kong residents will have a unique opportunity to develop their careers and help accelerate Canada’s economic recovery.”

Stream A: **Must**

- **Have a valid HKSAR or BNO passport**
- **Physically present in Canada with legal status when apply and when you get the PR**

Requirements:

- Language level – CLB 5 on all 4 skills
- In 3 years before you apply graduated in-Canada:
 - 2-year diploma, or
 - University degree or
 - 1-year certificate (post-secondary diploma or degree as a prerequisite to this program and must have completed this prerequisite program in the 5-year before you start this 1-year program)
- 50% completed in Canada (in person or online)

HK Pathway (PR) Stream **B**: Canadian Work Experience (ends 31Aug 2026)

- Graduate in the 5 years before you apply:
- Post-secondary:
 - (1) 2-year diploma or
 - (2) university degree or
 - (3) a 1-year certificate with prerequisite of post-secondary diploma or degree in 5 years before start this 1-year program.
- In-Canada education or if foreign education, equivalent to In-Canada education (ECA, wes..)
- Language level – CLB **5** on all 4 skills



Stream B:

Must

- **Have a valid HKSAR or BNO passport**
- **Physically present with legal status in Canada when apply and when you get the PR**

- Have worked in Canada for at least 12 months full-time (at least 30 hours a week) or an equal amount of part-time hours (at least 1,560 hours in total) in the 3 years before you apply.
- You **can't** include any hours of work that you spent
- As full-time student
- Self-employed
- Working outside Canada
- On leave (medical, parental or similar)
- On an extended absence outside Canada

1st Come to Study → HK Pathway (PR) Stream A

Advantages:

- Very Fast to succeed PR - may apply PR immediately upon graduation, and no need to have any work experience.
- Upon graduation, may receive a post-graduation work permit (PGWP) [Note: this is not Public Policy so the program opens with no expiry date set]

Obtaining a Work Permit

- Recent Graduate (HK Pathway)
- Spouse study/work in Canada
- Inter-company Transfer
- LMIA
- Caregivers Pathway
- Spousal Sponsorship in-Canada



HK Pathway (Work Permit) for Recent Graduate

Recent Graduate (Work Permit)



- Must holding valid HKSAR or BNO passport
- Graduated in Canada or abroad in the 5 years before you apply this work permit:
 - a university degree program or
 - 2-year post-secondary diploma or
 - 1-year program (with prerequisite requires post-secondary degree or diploma which completed no more than 5 years before start of this program.
- No age restriction
- No need to find employer prior to apply
- Open Work permit (i.e. may work for any employer in Canada)
- Work permit may valid for up to 3 years
- This is a public policy takes effect on Feb 8 2021 expires Feb 7 2023

PR Programs to consider: Express Entry/Start-Up/Self-Employed (may stay in Hong Kong till PR Visa issuance)



Self-employed

Relevant experience (only limited to cultural or athletics activities)

(If you want to obtain a work permit prior to PR, may contact us and setup an initial consultation with us.)



Start-up Visa

The program provides opportunities to private sector investors to establish their start-up business


